- 1. Special Issue on Education and training in Counselling and Related Fields ... to be published the end of 2017**
 - a. Teaching activities in the training of counsellors and counselling supervisors
 - b. Research on counselling education
 - c. Nature of and challenges faced in Australian counselling education
 - d. Outline of counselling accreditation/supervision standards in Australia

- 2. Special Issue on Applied Case Studies in Counselling and Related Fields ... to be published the end of 2018**
 - a. Various case studies (ethically submitted, of course) ... demonstrating a wide variety of counselling skills and theories in use to address a wide assortment of client difficulties

- 3. Special Issue on Ethics and Ethical Practice in Counselling and Related Fields ... to be published in 2019**
 - a. Differential applications of ethical standards in case studies
 - b. Comparison of various different ethical codes (Australian Counselling Association, Social Work, Psychology)
 - c. Ethical decision making
 - d. Research regarding the nature of ethical complaints in Australia and cost to professional associations
 - e. In-depth analysis of ethical elements – for instance a focus on confidentiality and duty to warn and protect with recent legal changes
